Standard Player's Agreement

Whereas the "Team" is a registered member of the Northern Ontario Junior Hockey League operating a Junior "A" hockey team in the town of Kirkland Lake, Ontario

Whereas the "Player" is eligible, qualified and has exhibited sufficient proficiency in his hockey skills to play for the "Team";

Whereas the "Player" wishes to participate as a member of the "Team" and the "Team" desires the services of the "Player"

Whereas the "Team" wishes to encourage the further development, education, training and advancement of the "Player" as a member of the "Team"

Purpose to provide an outline for the "Player" of the benefits of being a member of the "Team" and to outline the expectations of the "Team". This Agreement will be enforced at the discretion of the NOJHL commissioner and subject to any/all sanctions or discipline that may be administered by the NOJHL, NOHA, OHF or Hockey Canada.

The “Team” agrees:

- To provide the player with the opportunity to play and perform with the “Team” as a full time member with all of the benefits provided to all such “Players” (save and except a guarantee of amount of playing time)
- To provide access for the “Player” to participate in the Equipment Package offered by the “Team”
- To provide the opportunity to participate in the NOJHL annual premier showcase event subject to payment of the applicable fee stated herein
- To provide the benefits of the Player Team Fees as outlined subject to payment of the applicable fee stated herein
- To provide a refund to the “Player” if applicable as per the terms and conditions outlined in the NOJHL policies/procedures and as outlined herein. No such refund will be applicable in the event the “Player” quits or leaves the “Team” anytime during the season on his own accord or is suspended and/or loses his playing privileges as a result of the violation of any NOJHL or “Team” policies
- A “Player” who is traded or released, or who suffers a season ending injury, is entitled to a refund of any league or team participation fee based on the number of games remaining in the “Team’s” regular season schedule, as per the **“Refund Form”**
- Any violation of the NOJHL and/or “team” policies may result in suspension, loss of playing privileges and/or dismissal from the “Team” with or without refund any refund at the discretion of the NOJHL Commissioner
- That any dispute over any refund shall be made by the NOJHL Commissioner and any such decision is final and binding on all parties
- To provide to the NOJHL all requested documentation when a “Player” has been acquired, signed, released and/or his playing rights transferred
- To reimburse the “Player” any “Team” refund (if not disputed) within 14 days from the date of release on the Hockey Canada Registration (HCR) and once the “team” verifies that the “player” does not have any outstanding fees to the “Team” and/or Billet Family
- To ensure all necessary signatures are on the NOJHL “Standard Players Agreement” prior to the playing of any regular season games

The “League” agrees:

- The NOJHL Commissioner shall resolve any dispute over any refunds, such decision deemed final and binding on all parties
- To reimburse the “player” any league refund within 14 days as outlined herein

The “Player” agrees:

- To report to training camp in sound and good health and to perform at the level for the “Player” to be a member of the “Team”
- To attend all “Team” practices, games, training sessions and all other functions in a timely manner and in appropriate dress and deportment
- To attend and fulfill any educational commitments the “player” has during the playing season
- To permit the “Team” to monitor his activities and performance both on and off the ice and report to his “Parents” as may be required at the discretion of the “Team”
- To abide by all “team” and NOJHL policies
- To participate in local events, public appearances, school functions as a representative of the “Team”
- To conduct himself in all activities in an appropriate manner as a member of the “Team”
- To abide by the billet code of conduct

The “Parent(s)” agrees:

- To support the “Player” and to ensure the “Player” meets all of his conditions and obligations as a member of the “Team”

NOJHL League Fees – (\$1,200.00 plus 13% HST = \$1,356.00) Benefits include the following:

- Insurance Coverage
- Enhanced Medical and Dental Coverages
- Concussion Management Program
- Canadian Mental Health Association NOJHL Program
- Anti-Doping Education and Management Program
- Team NOJHL Participation in the Eastern Canadian All-Star Challenge

- NOJHL Technology and Communication Programs
- NOJHL League Administrative Costs
- NOHA, OHF, CJHL and Hockey Canada Fees
- Website and Fast Hockey Program Costs

Team Player Fees – (\$1,500.00 plus 13% HST = \$1695.00) Benefits include the following:

- Participation of “Team” in 56 regular season games
- Transportation (by highway coach) to all away regular season games
- Meals and Hotel costs (as determined) for all away regular season games (2 “Players” per/room)
- “Team” track suit
- Fitness/Gym membership at Joe Mavrinac Community Complex
- Access to personal off ice fitness trainer and nutritionist
- Access to team medical training staff
- Discounted rates for team physiotherapist, massage therapist, etc.
- On ice a minimum of 6 times per week
- Access to full-time coaching staff
- Participation in off-ice fitness workouts
- Participation in educational hockey video sessions
- Access to dedicated “Team” dressing room facilities
- Supply of Gatorade, tape, medical supplies, etc.

Player Equipment Package – (\$1,200.00) Benefits include the following:

- 6 quality CCM hockey sticks
- CCM hockey gloves
- Hockey pants
- Hockey helmet and visor

Showcase Fees – (\$350.00) Benefits include the following:

- Participation in a premier NOJHL league Showcase Event to increase “Team” and “Player” exposure

Monthly Billet Costs – (\$400.00) Benefits include the following:

- Appropriate/suitable accommodation with a local billet family
- Meals provided by billet family

The parties to this Agreement confirm acknowledge and agree that any violation of the terms of this Agreement will constitute a breach of the fundamental principles of the Northern Ontario Junior Hockey League and/or the “Team”.

A violation of this Agreement may result in immediate suspension of the “Player”.
